

Use of the Nursery Baskets

- Cemetery staff have the right to remove any item which is deemed inappropriate by the cemetery operator.
- Items must not protrude from the area of the basket or extend beyond the area of the memorial plaque on the ground below.
- Items may be hung from the basket providing they do not extend beyond the area of the memorial plaque on the ground below.
- Items must not exceed a height of 20cm from the top of the basket.
- Sharp, broken and dangerous items will be removed from the basket and stored for collection.
- Items which have deteriorated may be removed and stored for collection
- Should any Nursery Basket fall into disrepair due to extras which do not stand up to weather conditions, these baskets will be removed for collection
- Ipswich Cemeteries take no responsibility for personal items left at graves.

Materials

The Nursery Baskets are constructed in aluminium, which will withstand all weather conditions. Families may choose to powder coat the Nursery Basket in a colour of their choice, at the expense and arrangement of the families.

The baskets must not be painted as this will not stand up to weather conditions.



Warrill Park Lawn Cemetery - Nursery Baskets

Ipswich Cemeteries understands the deep desire of families to honour and remember their precious little ones by leaving personal items at their graves in the Nursery Sections of Warrill Park Lawn Cemetery.

In recognition of this heartfelt need, Ipswich Cemeteries, in collaboration with Friends of the Cemeteries and Ipswich City Council, engaged in meaningful discussions to create a solution that would allow families to place trinkets at their loved ones' graves while ensuring the ongoing maintenance of the Cemetery is not disrupted.

After careful consideration of several designs, the Nursery Basket emerged as the most compassionate and suitable option to support families in this sensitive task.

Only those Nursery Baskets purchased from Ipswich Cemeteries are permitted to be placed at Warrill Park Lawn Cemetery. The Nursery Baskets have only been

Nursery Baskets can be viewed at the office of Ipswich Cemeteries. The office is located within the grounds of Warrill Park Lawn Cemetery & Ipswich Crematorium and is open weekdays between the hours of 8:00am – 4:00pm.

Cost

Families may purchase Nursery Baskets from the Ipswich Cemeteries office at a cost of \$395.00. The price includes a matching aluminium nameplate. Families have the option of purchasing photos to be added to the nameplate.

Families are permitted to fix their own nameplate to the front of the basket, provided it fits in the designated area and is made from durable material that will stand up to weather conditions.

Nursery Section

The Nursery Section of Warrill Park Lawn Cemetery has a two vase policy. Graves which have a Nursery Basket in place are not permitted to have two vases in addition to the basket.

Any additional items left at the grave that are not held in an approved Nursery Basket will be removed and stored for collection for a period of 2 months to allow families to collect them. Any items not collected after 2 months will be respectfully disposed of.
